












Your Personal Life Counts Too!






- Make the care of people your first concern, treating them as individuals and respecting their dignity.

- Work as a team










Work with others to protect and promote the health and wellbeing of those in your care, their families and carers, and the wider community

- Ensure your skills and knowledge are up to date










- Be open and honest act with integrity and uphold the reputation of your Profession and University
