Additional Instructions

The instructions on the sheet work for Windows 2003 and earlier. The version in the laboratories is Windows 2007. To get into the Visual Basic editor the instructions in Task 2 no longer work. Instead follow the instructions below:

• Click on the circle symbol in the top left corner



- A menu should come up with an "Excel options" button at the bottom. Click on this.
- Check the box "Show Developer tab in the Ribbon" and click OK.
- Click on the **Developer** tab in the Ribbon
- Click on the Visual Basic icon at the left

You should now be able to rejoin the previous instructions

- Insert from the top menu
- Select Module 1 and you should be able to start editing your Visual Basic

• Click on the circle symbol in the top left corner



- A menu should come up with an "Excel options" button at the bottom. Click on this.
