

## SolidWorks 2011-2012 – Coursework

### *Exercise 3.*

In this exercise you should use the Part Design application to create a 3D solid model of the torque arm component, and then use the Generative Drafting application to create an engineering drawing from the solid model.

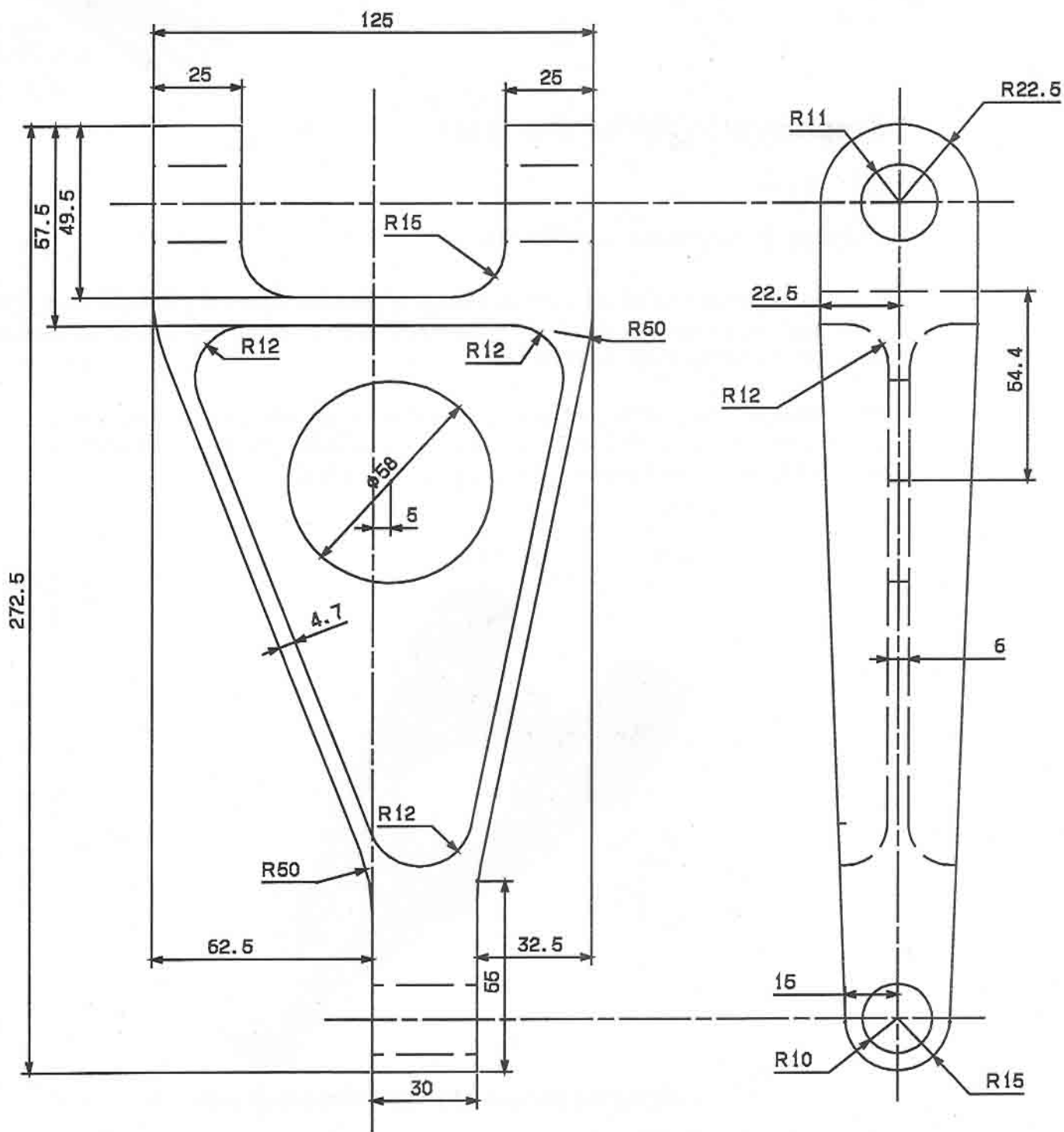
The component used in the exercise is a simplified version of the torque arm from an aircraft landing gear. A picture of the component is provided in figure 4.1 below, and details of the component are provided in figure 4.2 overleaf.

You may find it useful to use the Boolean “Common” operation to construct this part. You will need either two original part or create a new Part Body in your part in order to use a Boolean Common (intersect).
